Elective Sign-Up (5th Grade)

Students in 5th grade are now able to select elective classes for the 2024-2025 school year. Pre-Participation Physicals

Every school year the FHSAA requires an EL2 and EL3 form to be completed in order to participate in extracurricular athletics. This year, DSA is offering on-campus preparticipation physicals in connection with doctors from Nicklaus Children's Hospital. The cost of the physical at DSA is \$25.
