EARLY CHILDHOOD / ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Girls

- DSA blue or plaid dress (Pre-K-K ONLY)
- Polo with skirt/pants (skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)
- Sweater or jacket with DSA logo
- Solid black or white socks
- Approved all-black shoes (including logos, laces, and soles)
- A belt, if worn, should be black
- Solid white, navy, or black tights or leggings may be worn during cooler weather
- White long-sleeved shirt may be worn during cooler weather

Boys

- DSA polo with logo
- DSA gray shorts or pants with a black belt when appropriate
- Sweater or jacket with DSA logo
- Solid black or white socks
- Approved all-black shoes (including logos, laces, and soles)
- White long-sleeved shirt may be worn during cooler weather

Chapel Days: Students in grades 1-5 must wear the DSA oxford shirt with blue & white tie.

MIDDLE / HIGH SCHOOL

Girls

- Oxford shirt with DSA logo (tucked in)
- DSA skirt/skort or pants (skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)
- Sweater or jacket with DSA logo
- Solid black or white socks below the knee or full-length opaque tights
- All-black shoes (including logos, laces, and soles)
- Black belt should be worn with pants
- White long-sleeved shirt may be worn during cooler weather

Boys

- Oxford shirt with DSA logo (tucked in)
- DSA shorts or pants
- Sweater or jacket with DSA logo
- Solid black or white socks
- All-black shoes (including logos, laces, and soles)
- A belt, if worn, should be black
- White long-sleeved shirt may be worn during cooler weather

Chapel Days: MS/HS students must wear the blue & white tie with their usual uniform.

SHOE POLICY – *all grades*

Students are required to wear a solid black shoe. The shoe may be any brand and can be purchased wherever you would like, but it must follow these guidelines:

- Solid black (including logos, laces, and soles)
- Closed-toe and closed-heel
- Non-marking soles

Styles not allowed include combat boots, high-tops, sling-backs, heels higher than 1 inch, or any other style that would draw excessive attention to the wearer or distract from the look of the uniform.

Students may wear any non-marking gym shoe for Physical Education classes.
