COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Daily Message

Dear Parents,

We pray that your week has been a nice one. We resume classes on Monday and would like to communicate a few important items. Please read the following notes:

- The governor has canceled face-to-face instruction through May 1. This means that DSA will continue with online instruction through at least that time.
- The school calendar for the 2020-2021 school year is attached.
- Please know that our Divine Savior Academy staff, as well as the Divine Savior Church staff are here to support you in a variety of ways. The church staff has the following opportunities for spiritual encouragement:

- We are working to put together a nice handout to share information from our recent surveys. Please look for this in your inbox on Monday (April 6) evening. Some immediate changes we wanted to communicate include the following:
 - Early childhood and elementary students will have at least one “live” session during the day. This is optional for parents who want to make use of it.
 - We will continue to offer other “live” content throughout the week in the form of an evening story time, devotion, and other content for the early childhood and elementary levels.
 - Middle and high school students will have mandatory “live” sessions on Monday and Wednesday. An optional “live” session is available on Friday for asking questions and receiving additional support. (Please see the attached and revised schedule.)
 - Middle and high school students will also be required to login and mark themselves as present on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday during their normally scheduled class time as listed on the attached document. This will help provide a regular schedule for your child all five days of the week. If you would like your child to have greater flexibility and NOT be required to login during specified times on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, please complete [this form](#), so he/she will not be marked absent or penalized for missing the class. (Please complete this form by Tuesday, April 7).
 - We are happy to offer another day of “live” classes at the middle and high school level but also recognize the need to balance these “live” sessions with other options that provide meaningful opportunities for learning to take place.

As we have stated before, we are extremely thankful for your continued support and flexibility during this unprecedented time. Being a part of the DSA Family is truly an added blessing during this time. We completely understand that this situation affects all of us (parents, students, and teachers) in different ways. We want to be able to help in whatever ways we can. Please remember that you are always able to reach out with any question or concern during this time. It is a blessing that we can continue to support one another in the coming weeks.

Our next email will be sent on Sunday afternoon at 3:00 pm. This is a bit earlier than normal, but it will have important updates for middle and high school students regarding online learning expectations. May God's love give you continued support and peace. We close with the following prayer:
